

1 MS. MUMMA: Have a brief in before the 27th?
2 MR. CATTRAN: 21 days.
3 MS. MUMMA: I am wondering when you want something filed.
4 THE COURT: That should be sufficient, 27th.
5 MS. MUMMA: The 27th?
6 THE COURT: That will be the hearing date.
7 MS. MUMMA: The 27th at 1:30?
8 THE COURT: Yes. Then briefs in by the 23rd.
9 MS. MUMMA: Would the court consider extending the
10 surrender date until the date of the hearing?
11 THE COURT: Yes. When is the surrender date?
12 MS. MUMMA: The 10th, apparently.
13 THE COURT: Yes.
14 MS. MUMMA: Depending on the ruling of the court on the
15 27th, that a new surrender date would be selected?
16 THE COURT: We will set one right now. That will make it
17 May 11th.
18 MR. CATTRAN: Thank you, your Honor.
19 MS. MUMMA: One last request of Mr. Kubby, that he be
20 granted permission to leave and go to British Columbia and
21 return as ordered by the court on the 27th.
22 THE COURT: Fine. I take it he has run that by the
23 probation department first?
24 MR. CATTRAN: Your Honor, there is a representative of the
25 probation department in the courtroom.
26 MS. MUMMA: Is that okay?
27 PROBATION: That would be fine with probation. I would
28 like to clarify if the defendant is on probation at this time?

1 THE COURT: He is on probation. Probation was granted at
2 the time of sentencing. He has been formally on probation
3 since that time.

4 MS. MUMMA: Is probation okay with him going to British
5 Columbia?

6 MR. CATTRAN: Your Honor, can he be ordered to contact the
7 probation department within 48 hours of today's date?

8 MS. MUMMA: Why don't we have him discuss it now?

9 MR. CATTRAN: Within 48 hours.

10 THE COURT: Fine.
